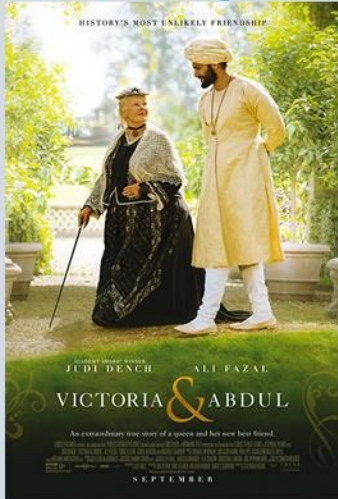


# Friday Night & Saturday Afternoon at the Movies



## ***Victoria & Abdul* (PG-13)**

**January 19 at 7 pm & January 20 at 1 pm**

The extraordinary true story of an unexpected friendship in the later years of Queen Victoria's (Judi Dench) remarkable rule. When Abdul Karim, a young clerk, travels from India to participate in the Queen's Golden Jubilee, he is surprised to find favor with the Queen herself... The two forge an unlikely and devoted alliance with a loyalty to one another that her household and inner circle all attempt to destroy.



## ***Dunkirk* (PG-13)**

**February 9 at 7 pm & February 10 at 1 pm**

The movie is based on a campaign in late May 1940 in the French port city of Dunkirk, where some 400,000 Allied soldiers, including more than 200,000 members of the British army, were penned in by the Germans. The British, faced with the capture or possible annihilation of their troops, initiated a seemingly impossible rescue.



## ***Marshall* (PG-13)**

**March 9 at 7 pm & February 10 at 1 pm**

This film revisits an early episode from the life of Thurgood Marshall, the civil rights lawyer who became the first African-American to hold a seat on the Supreme Court.
