Out of concern for the health of the community, volunteers and staff, the Briarcliff Manor Public Library will be suspending **all programs** for the month of March and, in conjunction with the other Westchester Libraries, suspending book holds from other libraries. (The Westchester Library System will be issuing a statement explaining this policy.)

Knowing how much the community uses its library, these were difficult decisions for all of us to make. We will continue to monitor the situation and make adjustments based on CDC and NYSDOH recommendations.

As of today:

- We are still open our usual hours.
- Extra hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, tissues and individual crayon packs are out for use.
- Our cleaning service will provide extra attention to high-use surfaces.
